This past month has been a productive time of deputation. We have had some truly wonderful meetings. The Lord continues to guide us and provide for our needs. We praise God that our current support level is now 75%!



On March ninth, with nearly the entire nation tensely awaiting the verdict, the Constitutional Court of South Korea upheld the National Assembly's decision to impeach President Park Geun Hye (박근혜) on charges of corruption. She was removed from office and is now subject to criminal prosecution for her crimes. There is a special presidential election set for May ninth. On social media and other platforms, many Koreans are expressing their earnest desire for a better future. They hope that a new president will usher in a new era of stability and prosperity.

While these desires are understandable, especially considering recent events (public corruption uncovered and a high rate of unemployment), no presidential candidate can ultimately deal with the great spiritual need of man. South Koreans need to be engaged with the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ. Only He can forgive their sin, reconcile them to the Father, and give them eternal life.



We have a great burden for Korean people (like the ones pictured) to have an opportunity to turn to Christ for salvation. This is a monumental time as South Koreans choose their next president. Please pray with us that the Gospel and the work of the ministry will not be hindered by the upcoming political changes.



While we are excited to return to Korea and preach the Gospel there, we must not forget about those all around us who are lost. When traveling on deputation, we have many opportunities to present the Gospel to a number of different people. One lady we met recently named Amber was very interested in hearing the

Gospel. Although she had been attending services at a cult, she readily invited us in and began to listen to the Gospel intently. We praise the Lord, that after hearing the Word of God and being convicted by the Holy Spirit, Amber made a profession of faith in Christ for salvation.
