We hope you are well and rejoicing in the Lord. This past month has been an exciting adventure as we have presented our ministry to churches in Alabama, Texas, Georgia, and Florida. The Lord has kept us safe through many miles of driving. We praise the Lord for helping us through our first vehicle difficulty while on deputation. On the way to a meeting, our car battery died about fifteen miles away from our destination. Praise the Lord we made it on time to the service, and were able to inexpensively fix the problem. Thank you so much for your prayers, we definitely experienced their effect.



While we are certainly enjoying deputation, we look forward to arriving on the field next year. The Lord has directed us to begin ministry (after language school) in the city of Busan. This city is the second largest in Korea and it is the fifth busiest seaport in the world. Three and one half million Korean people along with around 37,000 registered foreigners (including ethnic Koreans with foreign citizenship) make this city their home. According to the most recent national census data, 43% of the population self-identifies as atheist or non-religious, and



39% claim to be Buddhist. Sadly, very little is currently being done to biblically communicate the Gospel in this great city. With a daily average of seventy-one births and fifty-five deaths in the city, there is a staggering need for the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ to be properly communicated to the people of Busan before it is eternally too late.

When we lived in Korea we visited Busan several times. On one such occasion, we went to an observation tower. As we looked out over the city at dusk, we saw tens of thousands of homes and were deeply moved by the immensity of the task before us. Though it will be difficult to minister in Busan, we look forward to relying on the Holy Spirit for results that glorify God. It is our desire to preach the Gospel in Korean to the people of Busan, to establish a New Testament church with those who get saved, and to equip men whom the Lord calls to go out and start other biblical churches.
