Nearly 70% of the Korean Peninsula is mountainous; subsequently, many Korean cities have some of the highest population densities in the world. In fact, there are ten cities in Korea with a population at, or greater than, one million people. Most Koreans live in an urban setting and regularly use public transportation to commute to work and school. Day or night, you can always find many people walking around in the city; heading for restaurants, stores, and markets. Besides making for a very exciting environment, this also allows for many opportunities to pass out Gospel tracts and witness. Though there are certainly a number of people in Korea who are initially closed to the Gospel, one can almost always find someone willing to receive a tract or even listen to a Gospel presentation. When we return to Korea, it is our great desire to utilize the wonderful opportunity that the Korean city life presents to personally engage Koreans with Christ's Gospel.
