Dear Prayer and Financial Supporters,

We hope that this letter finds you well and blessed of the Lord. It has been our privilege to be out on deputation for eight months now. We have enjoyed the opportunity to meet God's people and see the Lord working mightily through His churches. We praise the Lord for His wonderful blessings of safety and provision. By the Lord's grace we have reached 31.5% of our needed monthly support!

Even as we enjoy deputation here in the States, we have an earnest desire to return to Korea and fervently communicate the gospel to the Korean people. Koreans are wonderful people; they are hardworking, industrious, and highly educated. Nearly everyone in Korea has heard of "Christianity" but most have never been personally engaged with the biblical gospel. Though South Korea is a secular country with nearly half of its people claiming to be atheist or non-religious, there is

a Protestant minority that comprises 18% of the

population. Many in the United States are

deceived by this number, thinking that Korea has been "evangelized." However, the undeniable reality is that the vast majority of Protestant churches in Korea are overrun with heretical teaching. False doctrines such as Dominionism, Pentecostalism, Calvinism, the social gospel, the prosperity gospel, and even works salvation are taught and widely embraced. It has been our experience, through careful study and several instances of personally witnessing to Korean Protestants, that most who claim to be "Christian" in Korea

have not had biblical salvation explained to them in

a manner in which they could understand and properly respond. Christianity devoid of the biblical gospel is in fact a false religion, no better than Buddhism or any other religious system. With this in mind, it is our great desire to be used by the Lord to preach the gospel of Christ to Koreans of every religious background and see the Holy Spirit draw them to the truth and simplicity that is found exclusively in Christ as revealed by Scripture.

This past month, God has allowed us to see fruit from witnessing. We praise the Lord for several people making solid professions of faith for salvation. Please pray that these individuals will grow in the Lord. Sometimes we plant, sometimes we water, and sometimes we reap; what a joy to know that God gives the increase.

Thank you so much for your prayer and financial support. It is our privilege to be your missionaries.
