Our journey began with a nearly two-hour drive down to San Francisco International Airport and then proceeded with a twelve-hour, non-stop flight to Incheon International Airport near Seoul. After clearing immigration and customs, we took a four-hour, high-speed KTX train ride down to Busan Station. We traveled nearly 6,000 miles in a total of 23 hours! We are indebted to those who prayed so

much for us; those prayers were definitely answered. Our visas came at just the right time and the Lord gave us a great price on our plane tickets. We are so glad that we have arrived in Korea safely (along with all of our luggage)! The Lord has truly shown Himself strong in our lives. He has taken us through deputation and has planted us in His harvest field. Our hearts are grateful for His goodness to us.
