This past month has been a busy yet rewarding time as we continue to study Korean, distribute Gospel tracts, and seek opportunities to present the Gospel in our city. Our dear daughter JoAnn is growing every day and has recently learned how to sit on her own. We are so thankful to the Lord for entrusting her to us. It is a great blessing to serve the Lord together as a family.

Early in the morning an elderly lady comes down our street, pushing a cart and noisily advertising with a loudspeaker. As we heard her pass by every day, we naturally became very curious to know what she might be selling. Recently, Sarah and JoAnn were walking through our neighborhood one afternoon and saw the same lady with her cart. Sarah stopped to talk with her and discovered that she was selling special clam soup. After a small conversation, Sarah bought some of the soup, was able to give her a Gospel tract, and we later enjoyed a delicious meal. Serving the Lord here in Korea is always an interesting adventure! As we interact daily with people in our neighborhood, we are reminded of how much they need to be personally engaged with the true Gospel. We are praying that the Lord would give us opportunities to witness to them and that He would remove the barriers, open their eyes, and draw them to Himself for salvation.



Sarah and I are continuing in our language studies. We are experiencing small but measured progress. I will take a major exam this coming week. As we learn Korean grammar, we are beginning to understand the subtleties of Korean culture. Korean people tend to express themselves less directly and more politely than we typically do in English. This understanding helps us as we seek to connect with Korean people and communicate the Gospel of Christ to them. Please pray that the Lord would continue to bless our language studies so that we may be an effective witness for His glory.

We praise the Lord for two recent opportunities to present the Gospel with fellow students at my university, one of whom claims to be an atheist. Please pray that the Lord would convict them of their sin and convince them of His true Gospel. Please also pray for the salvation of our downstairs neighbors, our landlords, and Sarah's Korean teacher. We long for them to come to Christ and be saved.
