



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We hope that this letter finds you well and experiencing the blessings of the Lord. As we move into the warmer spring weather here in Busan, we are so grateful for how our Lord guides us and provides for our needs. We greatly appreciate your prayers as we continue to learn Korean and seek to communicate the Gospel to those around us.

As we have been adjusting to ministry in Korea, it has been very fascinating to learn more about the people that our Lord has called us to reach. Though they have a long history, a rich culture, and a highly industrialized economy, they have a great spiritual need for the Gospel of Christ. The vast majority of the Korean people here in Busan claim to be atheist/non-religious or Buddhist.



They do not have a biblical concept of God, Jesus Christ, or the true Gospel. Their worldview is very different from many nominally "Christian" Americans. As we contemplated ways to reach these people, the Lord impressed upon our hearts the desire to develop a detailed Gospel tract that would carefully present the truth about God and eternal life. After we prayed and carefully wrote the tract in English, our dear brother, Assistant Pastor James Kim, expertly translated it into Korean. This tract uses over forty Scripture verses and contains a biblical presentation of God, creation, sin, the Gospel, and how anyone can be truly saved through the Lord Jesus Christ alone. We will be ordering several thousand of these tracts from the printer this week. Please pray with us that Korean people would receive the tracts as we distribute them, that they would read them, and that the Lord would use His Word to draw lost souls to Himself for salvation.



While we focus on learning the Korean language and culture, it has been our privilege to serve the Lord under a veteran national pastor, Pastor Kim Hee Ok, who was led to Christ by missionaries many years ago. We are so grateful to learn from his faithful example. His assistant pastor, Brother James Kim and his wife Hanna, have also been such a blessing to our family. They so graciously helped us with many important tasks when we first arrived, and they continue to be a source of encouragement as we serve the Lord here in Korea. We are thankful to have learned much about ministry in Korea from them. One of the ways that we get to serve the Lord in Pastor Kim's church is through leading a children's church service. We are able to teach Bible



truths (through a translator) and spiritual songs to a wonderful group of children. The children participate enthusiastically; they listen intently to the lesson and are able to answer questions. Several of them are not yet saved and we are praying for the Lord to convict their hearts and draw them to Himself for salvation.

Thank you so much for your prayers! It is our privilege to be partnered with you for the sake of the Gospel going forth in Korea. May the Lord bless you as you serve Him!
