Since he spoke exceptional English, we were able to have a good conversation over the phone. Though he claimed to come from a Protestant background, it became evident that he had never been saved. He seemed to believe that his own achievements could merit favor with God; so, I attempted to patiently and carefully communicate the Bible truth about salvation to him. Though he was

likely experiencing some conviction, I sensed that he was allowing his pride to prevent him from turning to Christ alone for salvation. Please continue to pray with us for souls like this one to be saved as we communicate the Gospel of Christ to the Korean people.

The biblical pattern for missions is the establishment of local churches that biblically propagate the Gospel, diligently teach sound doctrine, and replicate themselves by sending out trained men to start other biblical churches. We are praying that the Lord would guide us in His perfect timing to the exact location in our city where He would have us to begin the process of planting a church. In the meantime, we believe the Lord is leading us to continue in our current

status of preparation and intensive language studies for a bit longer in order to be better equipped for the task of church-planting in Korea. Please pray that the Lord would guide our steps and show us His will as we seek to bring glory to Him.
