Here in Busan, we are enjoying the beautiful autumn season. Temperatures have cooled and the mountains that surround our city are displaying spectacular fall foliage. We continue to labor at our Korean language studies. Though it is often difficult, our family is committed to gaining proficiency. We certainly need the Lord's help in order to study efficiently. Thank you for praying for us as we learn Korean!



The densely populated district where we live is also the location of an ancient fortress. Last month, a festival was held to commemorate its historical importance. Since several thousand people had gathered to participate in the events, it was a good Gospel tract distribution opportunity. At the history festival, an acquaintance of ours greeted us warmly. We originally met this man last year at the restaurant his family owns in our neighborhood, and since then we have had several casual conversations with him. Wisdom is needed as we continue to develop this relationship. Please pray that we could lead this man (and other acquaintances) to the saving knowledge of the Lord Jesus Christ. We believe that it is vital for us to have a dual approach in our Gospel outreach endeavors: placing Gospel tracts directly into the hands of hundreds of people each week (whom we would otherwise never meet) as well as developing relationships with individuals in order to lead them to Christ.



Recently, while distributing Gospel tracts in a residential area, I came across a large Buddhist temple. Inside, several people were kneeling before golden statues including two mothers and their daughters. As I saw the young girls being instructed by their mothers in the false ways of Buddhism, I was moved by this poignant reminder of why the Lord has called us to communicate His Gospel here in Korea. While not every one of the three and a half million residents of our city is devoted to such obvious idolatry, the reality for all

those who have not yet been born again is the same: they are lost and under condemnation. Please continue to pray with us that we would reach Korean people with the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ in these last days!

Thank you again for praying for Sarah's father's recovery from lung cancer surgery. He is recovering well, but will undergo three months of chemotherapy treatment in order to minimize the risk of the cancer recurring. We know that his health is in the Lord's hands. Thank you so much for your faithful prayer and financial support. We are honored to represent you as we work to communicate the Gospel of Jesus Christ to the Korean people.
