Like you all, we continue to deal with the ramifications of the worldwide COVID-19 pandemic. Despite relatively very low numbers of new Coronavirus cases, the government's strong mitigation measures remain in place. We are grateful however, that religious gatherings of fifty or less are now being permitted in our city as long as strict guidelines are followed. This past month we were able to go back out on the streets and distribute Gospel tracts. We praise the Lord for the many souls that received a clear presentation of the Gospel in written form. As the government has pledged to restructure society and permanently reduce human-to-human contact in response to the Coronavirus, we need great wisdom from the Lord as we seek to navigate these challenges and communicate the true Gospel of Christ in these last days.

According to the Scripture, God's plan for missions is the establishment of independent, self-governing, self-replicating biblical churches that faithfully and fervently communicate the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Right now, we are preparing to plant such a church here in Busan. After praying over several areas, we feel the Lord directing us to *Jin-gu*, which is the central district of our city. This densely populated area has many residential neighborhoods while also being an important hub for commerce and transport. We believe that *Jin-gu* will be a strategic location from which we can reach other areas in our city with the truth. We will work to communicate the Gospel as we seek to connect with people and organize Bible studies. Especially in the beginning, this will likely be a slow process, but we will rely on the Lord to bless His Word and open hearts to the truth. As souls are saved and follow the Lord in baptism, we will then organize into a local church. As we prepare to move to *Jin-gu* in the near future, we need to find a suitable place to live and start a church. Leasing even a small space requires a very large sum of money, which through your support we have been saving for. Please pray that the Lord would guide us very specifically and provide exactly the right place in His perfect timing. Planting a church in this spiritually dark city is not something we can do through our own abilities, yet we eagerly anticipate what the Lord will do through us for His glory. Please pray that the Lord would work through us to build His church in Busan. We will keep you updated as we transition into this exciting new phase of ministry. May the Lord bless you as you serve Him!
