As we distribute Gospel tracts, our goal is not only to disseminate the Word of God to the frenetically busy people of Busan but also to personally witness when the Lord gives opportunity and to make contact with those whom we might connect with later on. Recently, I received a phone call from a man who had received one of our tracts. During the hour or so that we spoke together he asked me questions about the Bible, the Gospel, and the true nature of God. It was evident that he was lost, having had little actual exposure to the truth and being confused by false teaching he found on the internet. What a great joy it was to communicate the glorious Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ to him and try to answer his questions from the Word of God that evening! Please pray that we could develop a relationship with this man and lead him to Christ. We are confident that the Lord of the Harvest is at work as we labor to sow the seed!

We so appreciate your faithful prayers for the church that the Lord is using us to plant in the central district of Busan. Last month, I continued to search Jingu for the building that the Lord would have us to lease. In part due to the actions of an evil cult group at the beginning of the pandemic back in 2020, many building owners want nothing to do with any kind of church or religious organization. I heard this sentiment several times when inquiring after buildings recently. However, we are not discouraged but instead are excited about what the Lord has in store. Based on our experience thus far, we have narrowed our search to three areas within the central district of Busan. Please continue to pray that we will be sensitive to the Lord's leading as we seek to do His perfect will. May our Lord continue to protect and bless you as you faithfully serve Him!
