What a joy it is to represent you as we serve the Lord, working to communicate the truth of the Gospel to those whom our Lord desires to save here in Busan, Korea. Over the past several weeks we have been blessed with an especially beautiful spring season. The blossoms and flowers were a vivid testimony of the Lord's greatness and goodness. The warmer temperatures we experienced made distributing Gospel tracts a bit easier. Sarah even had some people come up and ask her for a tract while we were passing them out near a large university on a recent Sunday afternoon. Last month we celebrated our second daughter Hannah's first birthday in the traditional Korean way. It was a special time for our family to thank God for entrusting us with this precious little girl.

I had the most unexpected opportunity to see the president-elect of South Korea up close when he briefly visited Busan recently. I had no idea he was coming; yet I surprisingly found myself in a traditional market where he was scheduled to deliver a speech. Though security was tight, I was somehow allowed to go and stand just a few yards from the podium. About twenty minutes later, the president-elect arrived, surrounded by numerous Presidential Security Service agents. The people all around me cheered enthusiastically during his speech when he promised to do his best to save the struggling Korean economy. After finishing his speech, he came over to the barrier and greeted those of us standing there with a presidential fist bump! While it was definitely an exciting moment to see the one who will rule this nation beginning on May 10th when he is inaugurated, it is quite sobering to think of how so much authority and power are entrusted to one fallible man. Through this special experience I have been motivated to pray even more earnestly that President Yoon would turn to Christ for salvation and rule this nation wisely so that we may communicate the Gospel and do the work of the ministry with minimal restriction in these last days before our Savior returns for His own.

In our previous prayer letter I mentioned that I had the privilege to briefly present the Gospel to a lady who received a tract from me. Since then, this lady has called me several times and I have been able to share the truth with her more thoroughly. The many difficulties that she has experienced along with the deceptive teachings of Buddhism and other false religions that she has been exposed to have greatly confused her. In trying to properly minister to her we have sought the Lord for wisdom and turned to the Scriptures for answers. Like so many here, her mind has been blinded by "the god of this world." Please pray with us that we might be used to "shine the light of the glorious gospel of Christ" so that this lady would turn from idols to the True and Living God for eternal salvation.

Our search continues for the place that the Lord would have us to lease for use as a church facility. Though we certainly wish that we had already found a suitable location by now, we know that the Lord will guide us to the right place in His time. Therefore we keep on searching while seeking wisdom from above. As we have mentioned before, a suitable facility in a good location will be an important tool for communicating the Gospel as we continue to seek to connect with people and teach them the Word of God.
