Our family truly has so many reasons to be thankful. By the grace of God, last month we welcomed new visitors to Jungbu Independent Baptist Church, distributed many Gospel tracts around our city, and personally shared the Gospel with lost souls. We also experienced the great joy of my mother and my father (who serves the Lord as an assistant pastor at our home church—Madison Baptist Church of Madison, Alabama) visiting us for the last two weeks of November. From the moment they arrived until we bid them farewell, the Lord granted us the most wonderful time together. It was such a joy to show them our mission field and our ministry. Precious, unforgettable memories were made as they spent time together with us. I had the great honor of translating for my father when he preached in our church's Wednesday evening Bible study. My parents were such an encouragement to us throughout their stay. We thank God for granting this wonderful blessing to our family!

At the beginning of November, we rejoiced greatly when a lady who had received one of our Gospel tracts while visiting her daughter in Busan several months ago came to Jungbu Independent Baptist Church on the first Sunday of the month, bringing the tract she received with her. She came from another city, riding various buses for two hours on her way to our church. It was quite evident that the Lord miraculously brought her in! After spending most of her life without any religious belief, she recently became interested in Christianity in the last two years, unfortunately initially receiving bad influence from false teachers on YouTube. However, it seems that she was genuinely seeking the Lord and that God was actively guiding her towards the truth. She listened intently to the preaching of the Word of God at our church on that Sunday. At the conclusion of the service as I began to speak to her about salvation, she said eagerly, "Oh, I want to be saved! How can I be saved?" After Sarah and I had counseled with her from the Scriptures for about an hour, it was such a joy to see her pray, earnestly professing faith in Christ and His finished work for her salvation! Praise the Lord! Because she lives so far away, we do not know when this dear lady will be able to return. We gave her a Bible and some of our Bible study materials to help her grow in the Lord. That afternoon Miss Kim went on her way rejoicing. We pray that the Lord protects her and continues to guide her in truth. What a wonderful privilege it was to lead this precious soul to a saving knowledge of Christ!

We thank the Lord for how He has worked recently in the life of Miss Go, the lifelong Buddhist who came after reading one of our Gospel tracts and made a profession of faith in Christ alone for her eternal salvation back in July. After coming to several consecutive services in August, followed by a period of unexplained absence, she returned once in September but sadly experienced difficulties again that night with her persistent anxiety. Though we subsequently contacted her several times, she did not respond. However, while I was distributing Gospel tracts two weeks ago, God providentially caused our paths to cross. It was a brief but positive interaction. We rejoiced and thanked God when Miss Go surprisingly attended our Wednesday Bible study last week! Despite emotional discomfort which she attributed to the presence of a man who began attending our church back in August, she listened intently to the Word of God that night and seemed to experience some victory over her anxiety. Truly we serve a God who answers prayer! Please continue to pray with us that God would grant Miss Go some lasting relief from her great distress and that she would grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. Please also continue to pray that the Lord would work through us to reach others for His honor and glory. Thank you so much for faithfully partnering together with us in the work of proclaiming the Gospel of Christ to the Korean people! It is our great honor to serve the Lord together with you. May the Lord continue to bless you!
